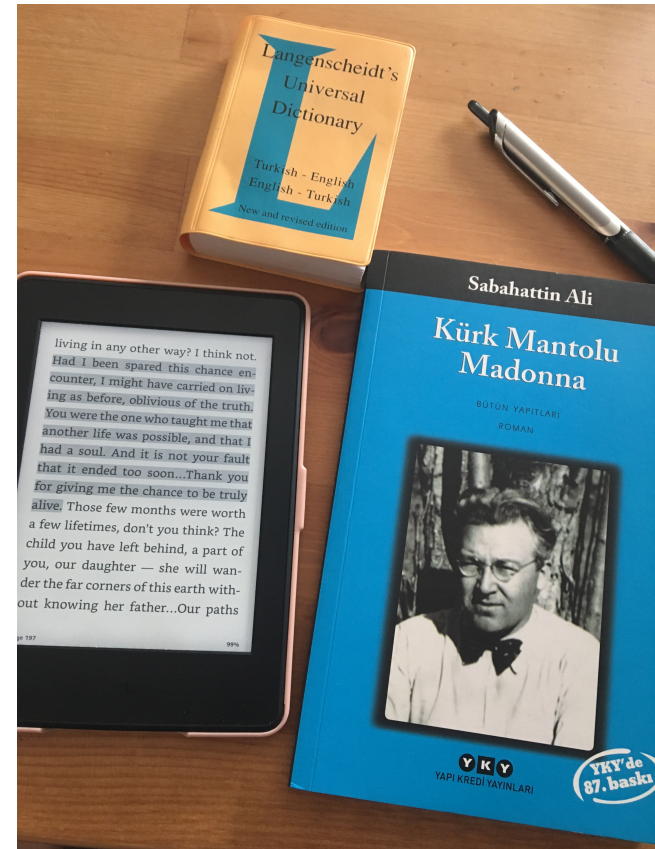




Language Learning and Lifelong Learners: A Call to Humility, Curiosity, and Empathy
