





- 02 Bold title
- Blank double-spaced line before byline
- Course, instructor, due date provided
- Calibri and other accessible fonts okay



EASIER REFERENCES FOR ONLINE SOURCES

- 01 References label is bold
- URLs and DOIs can be live links, auto-formatted, and shortened
- "Retrieved from" no longer precedes a URL
- Place of publication no longer needed for books
- Up to 20 authors listed in a reference entry





In-Text Citation for Articles



Quotation

- Parenthetical: (Jensen, 2010, p. 5)
- Narrative: Jensen (2010) stated, "The results of this global warming study are skewed to present a problem that has political pull" (p. 5).

Paraphrase

- Parenthetical: (Jensen, 2010)
- Narrative: Jensen (2010) believes the results are being misconstrued to support a political agenda.

Reference for a blog article

Author, A. A. (Year, Month day). Title of article. Blog Title. URL

Reference for an editorial article

Author, A. A. (Year). Title of article [Editorial]. Periodical Title, volume(issue), pages. DOI or URL




Shakespeare, loosely paraphrased, once wrote that a rose by any other name is still a rose, and that idea, by extension, now applies to APA Style as familiar terms.




ENHANCED SEARCH IN PG CAMPUS

Search Suggestions Based on Resource Titles




